What will I need?

A minimum of 64 UCAS tariff points (2017 onwards)

OR successful completion of a recognised access course with at least 60 credits (including 45 at Level 3)

OR business experience in the computing industry and IT-related skills (over 21s only) and assessed via interview. AND GCSE maths and English at grade C/4 (or equivalent)

How long is the course?

The course runs for 33 weeks per year for two years during which candidates will attend directed study lessons for approximately 12 hours per week.

What will I do?

You will need to take units giving a total of 240 credits for HND over a two year period:
