FINANCIAL SUPPORT AVAILABLE FOR UNIVERSITY LEVEL COURSES

Student Finance England

The Government offers a wide range of student financial support in the form of grants, loans and university/higher education institution bursaries. If you're studying a BSc (Hons) Degree, Foundation Degree, Higher National Certificate, Higher National Diploma or Post Compulsory Education course you can apply for financial support from the government through Student Finance England. The main sources of help available are grants which you don't pay back and loans which you do.

If you are eligible you can apply for:

- Tuition Fee Loan – to help with the cost of tuition fees
- Maintenance Loan – to help with accommodation and other living costs (full-time students only)
- Childcare Grant – to help with childcare costs for children under 15, or under 17 if they have special educational needs (full-time students only)
- Parents' Learning Allowance – to help students with children pay for books, study materials and travel (full-time students only)
- Adult Dependents' Grant – to help students with an adult who depends on them financially (full-time students only)
- Disabled Students' Allowance – to help students with a disability

Please note that the College is sadly unable to grant a tuition fee waiver of any sort, regardless of personal circumstances.

Loan Repayments

The earliest you will start repaying any loans is the April after you leave your course and only when your annual income is over £25,000. You will stop paying if your income drops below this amount. You pay back 9% of your income over the minimum amount of £25,000. Examples of repayments are shown in the table below.

Total Earnings	Monthly Repayment
£25,000 and under	£0
£30,000	£37
£35,000	£75
£50,000	£187
