Course Content

Painting & Decorating - painting and wall paper techniques

A current skills shortage of painters and decorators is a serious threat to the industry, with nearly 19% of staff due to retire within the next four years and predicted to rise to 25% after that. Having skills in painting and decorating will provide people with the platform to have fulfilling careers and this is one of the trades where many people become self-employed and run their own businesses. In this course, you will study a number of practical units which will give you an introduction to the Painting and Decorating industry. Prepare surfaces for decorating, Apply paint by brush and roller, Apply foundation and plain papers.

The programme provides comprehensive practical skills training and assessment with associated construction theory in safe working practices and building methods.

This is a practical course aimed at learners seeking to gain basic construction skills. Achievement is measured by the completion of a portfolio of evidence.
