What you can expect in your interview

You are expected to provide a five minute PowerPoint presentation on the topic 'Why Podiatry?' Please bring this on the day, on a memory stick, and also email a copy to esther.sabin@bmet.ac.uk no later than 5 pm the day before your interview.

Be prepared to talk about the topic 'what does compassion mean to you?' for approximately 5 minutes. To enable you to do this we would like you to bring with you an item/object to help demonstrate your explanation.

How to prepare for your values based interview day

Please ensure you bring the following documentation with you to the interview:

- Original Certificate or Results Slip or Transcript, if already obtained, as evidence of:
 - Degree Level Certificate (if applicable)
 - Level 3 and above qualifications (for example, A Level, BTEC Extended Diploma, HNC/D and Access to HE Diploma)
 - Level 2 English Language or Literacy (for example, GCSE)
 - Level 2 Mathematics or Numeracy (for example, GCSE)
- Evidence of Proof of Identity a valid passport or photo driving license.
- An item/object for the compassion element of your interview.
- Your five minute PowerPoint presentation on a memory stick.

Finance information
