


Flexible entry

Part-time options

Part-time study is a flexible and cost-effective way to realise your potential, providing an opportunity to do a university level course that fits in around your lifestyle. You can build upon existing skills, discover a new career path, or pursue your interests. 
The tuition fees for university level courses starting in September 2021 are subject to government policy and approval. The tuition fees for professional courses will not be available until the Summer Term of the academic year 2020-21.

Additional costs may be added for purchasing compulsory textbooks, a uniform, sportswear or kit, equipment or to take part in educational visits.

When the tuition fees and additional costs have been confirmed, we will display them on our website.

At BMet, we provide a wide range of academic and pastoral support which include:

- an assigned personal tutor
- one-to-one tutorials with module lecturers

Applications

Full-time

Applications to study a full-time BA (Hons) Degree, BSc (Hons) Degree, Foundation Degree, Higher National Certificate or Higher National Diploma course at BMet are made via APPLY through the Universities and Colleges Admission Service (UCAS). APPLY is a secure, web-based application system.

If you're applying as an individual, i.e. not through a school, college or centre, you will need to answer a few questions to confirm your eligibility before you can start your application. If you're applying through a school, college or centre, you'll need to obtain a 'buzzword' from the centre you're applying through. This buzzword links your application to your centre, so that your referee can write and attach their reference.
