



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The A – V of qualifications we've got you covered!

A Levels

To study a programme of three A levels with us, we ask that you have a minimum of five GCSEs at Grade 4 and above – including maths and English plus subject specific requirements and an average point score of five. For A level arts related subjects, we also need to see your portfolio (at least five pieces of your work). Please check course details for any specific course entry requirements.

A levels

Apprenticeships

A programme of study alongside a role in industry – designed to give you the skills, knowledge and understanding to make an impact in your chosen job role.

Vocational Qualifications

Vocational qualifications involve a mix of practical and theoretical study, that will develop specific skills and understanding linked to a particular field and will prepare you for further/ higher education or employment.

English & Maths

Developing your English and maths skills is a vital part of your programme of study at BMet. If you haven't already achieved a 9-4 grade (the equivalent of an A*-C) grade in English and maths, we will help you work towards this. We also offer Functional Skills and ESOL qualifications from entry level to Level 2.

Qualifications in these subjects:

- are valued by employers and all education providers
- support you to get a job or progress to higher level courses /university
- help you develop skills which will be useful in your everyday life.
